Mass Schedule for Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary:

The annual blessing of candles and procession will take place before the evening Mass only. We will bless all of the candles which will be used throughout the entire liturgical year. You are encouraged to bring your own candles that you will use for personal devotions to be blessed as well. Either drop them off on Sunday, January 31 or bring them Tuesday evening prior to the Mass (Please be sure to arrive no later than 10 minutes prior to Mass). Be sure to label candles with your name.
