CLARIFICATION—SINGING BY THE FAITHFUL

There is some confusion about when the faithful should sing along with the choir and when they should not during Mass. There are two particular times that you are encouraged to join the choir:

- The entrance hymn at the beginning of Mass.
- The recessional hymn at the end of Mass. Please sing out!

Regarding the other pieces of chant which are sung during Mass such as the *Introit* and the *Kyrie*, do not sing along. Those parts are more difficult to sing properly, and require the practice given to them by the choir members in order to be done as well as possible.
