## ROSARY AFTER 10AM MASS

## WEDNESDAY EVENING COMPLINE

On Wednesday evenings the priests usually sing Compline (the final hour of the Divine Office) following the 7:30pm Mass. The faithful in attendance are welcome to join in singing, and books are provided. Beginning this Wednesday evening, one of the priests will lead a 20 minute practice at 7:00pm and go through a portion of the chant to be sung at Compline that night. The practice will be held in the second classroom. Each Wednesday that we will have one of these practices it will be announced in the previous Sunday's bulletin.

## STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS

State lawmakers are considering legislation that would retroactively nullify the statute of limitations for filing a civil lawsuit alleging childhood abuse. This proposed legislation would only apply to private and nonprofit organizations, but not public schools or government agencies (83% of PA students attend public schools).
