## ROSARY AT ABORTUARY

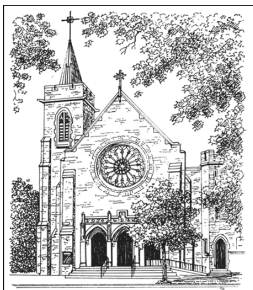
