CANDLEMAS, THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 2ND

Mass Schedule for Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary:

- 7:10am – Low Mass
- 7:00pm – Low Mass with Blessing of Candles and Procession

The annual blessing of candles and procession will take place before the evening Mass only. We will bless all of the candles which will be used throughout the entire liturgical year. You are encouraged to bring your own candles that you will use for personal devotions to be blessed as well. Either drop them off on Sunday, January 29, or bring them Thursday evening prior to the Mass (be sure to arrive no later than 15 minutes prior to Mass). Be sure to label candles with your name.

ST. BLAISE THROAT BLESSING

On Friday, February 3rd, after the morning and evening masses the blessing of throats will be available. Also, co-op students may receive the blessing after the morning classes.

EPIPHANY WATER
