Because St. Patrick is the patron of the diocese of Harrisburg, Bishop Gainer has granted a dispensation from the obligation to abstain from meat on this day. He does recommend abstaining from meat on another day of that week in place of Friday. Abstaining from meat is still obligatory for every other Friday.
