Homebound Parishioners

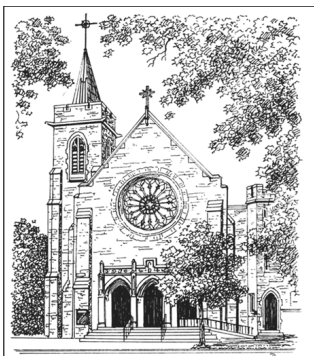
