As the Mass proceeds and sunrise approaches, the church becomes progressively brighter, illumined by the sun as our Faith is illumined by Christ.

The priests would be happy to provide the following to any expecting lady at her request. Please do not hesitate to ask.

- **Blessing of Expectant Mother**

Can be given at any time during pregnancy.

- **Candle in Honor of St. Raymond Nonnatus**

To be taken home and burned, and especially when the time of delivery approaches.

- **St. Torellus Water**

Special Holy Water which can be sprinkled, used to bless oneself, drunk, or used in small amounts in cooking.
