Gospel *Matt 22:15-21*

At that time, the Pharisees went and took counsel how they might trap Jesus in His talk. And they sent to Him

their disciples with the Herodians, saying, Master, we know that You are truthful, and that You teach the way of God in truth, and that You care naught for any man; for You do not regard the person of men. Tell us, therefore, what do You think: Is it lawful to give tribute to Caesar, or not? But Jesus, knowing their wickedness, said, Why do you test Me, you hypocrites? Show Me the coin of the tribute. So they offered Him a denarius. Then Jesus said to them, Whose are this image and the inscription? They said to Him, Caesar's. Then He said to them, Render, therefore, to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's.

Adult Catechism Class

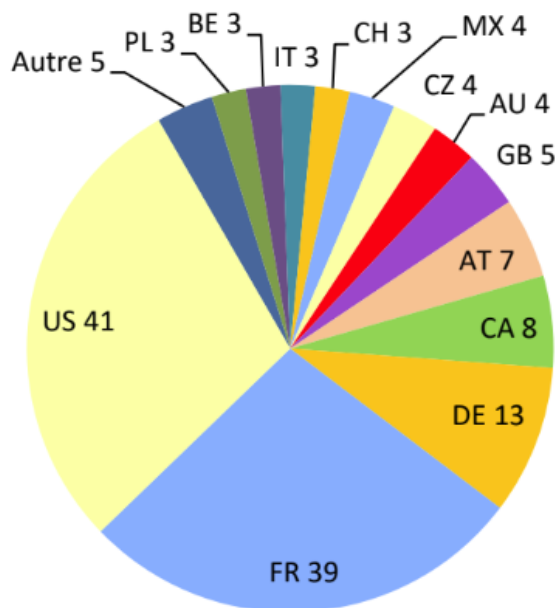
