### **PROPERS OF THE MASS**

#### Lesson 1 Pet 3:8-15.

Beloved: Be all like-minded in prayer, compassionate, lovers of the brethren, merciful, reserved, humble; not rendering evil for evil, or abuse for abuse, but contrariwise, blessing; for unto this were you called that you might inherit a blessing. For, He who would love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no deceit. Let him turn away from evil and do good, let him seek after peace and pursue it. For the eyes of the Lord are upon the just, and His ears unto their prayers; but the face of the lord is against those who do evil. And who is there to harm you, if you are zealous for what is good? But even if you suffer anything for justice' sake, blessed are you. So have no fear of their fear and do not be troubled. But hallow the Lord Christ in your hearts. *Gospel Matt 5:20-24* 

At that time, Jesus said to His disciples: Unless your justice exceeds that of the Scribes and Pharisees, you shall not enter the kingdom of heaven. You have heard that it was said to the ancients, 'You shall not kill'; and that whoever shall kill shall be liable to judgment. But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother shall be liable to judgment; and whoever says to his brother, 'Raca,' shall be liable to the Sanhedrin; and whoever says, 'You fool!', shall be liable to the fire of Gehenna. Therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar, and there remember that your brother has anything against you, leave your gift before the altar and go first to be reconciled to your brother; and then come and offer your gift.

Use of Holv Water in the Home: Please note that the holv water font has been moved to the front entrance of the church so that it can be accessed more conveniently, and hopefully used more frequently. I encourage you to bring small containers to take Holy Water to your homes, and to use it to purify yourself, your family, and your home. It is a reminder of our baptism, as the Reverend Philip Weller tells us: "The holy water font is a counterpart of the baptismal font; the sacramental is related to the great sacrament. Easter is the day of Holy Baptism par excellence, and every Sunday is a little Easter. Consequently, on the

Lord's day the Church blesses water to be used in the renewal of baptism, for so often as she sprinkles us with the blessed water, a sign is given us of renewal of the pristine life once bestowed by the Gift of Life-baptism."

The words of the blessing of the water teach us of its great power in our daily lives: "O God, Who for man's salvation dost dispense wondrous mysteries with the efficacious sign of water, hearken to our Prayer-pouring forth thy benediction upon this element which we consecrate with manifold purifications. Let this creature serve thee in expelling demons and curing diseases. Whatsoever it sprinkles in the homes of the faithful, be it cleansed and delivered from harm. Let such homes enjoy a spirit of goodness and an air of tranquility, freed from baneful and hidden snares. By the sprinkling of this water may everything opposed to the safety and repose of them that dwell therein be banished, so that they may possess the well-being they seek in calling upon thy holy name, and be protected from all peril."

Please take Holy Water to your homes and use it frequently!



South Street Garage: We apologize for any inconvenience that was caused last Sunday due to the lack of vouchers. Anyone who parked at the South Street Garage last Sunday, and did not receive an exit voucher, please email secretary@stlawrence.cc with a picture of your ticket and receipt for reimbursement. You are able to park for free on Sundays at South Street Garage. The procedure for using the garage is as follows: 1. Enter the garage using the Susquehanna Street entrance. 2. At the gate, take an entrance ticket. 3. Go to Mass and ask an usher for an exit voucher. (The exit voucher functions as your payment method). 4. When departing, use both the entrance ticket and the exit voucher at the departure gate. Any problems please notify Fr. Smith.
